



## **Pool Rules & Regulations**

### **MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. All persons, including Members, upon entering the pool facility must sign-in on the registration log.
2. Member's Guests must be signed in by a member on the registration log.
3. In-county guests are allowed (5) pool visits per season. Out-of-County guests are allowed unlimited visits, but must be accompanied by a member at all times.
4. A \$10.00 guest fee applies to the any non-Member, immediately. If you do not pay for your guest, it will be charged to your card on file with the Clubhouse.
5. Member Grandparents may bring grandchildren if supervised at all times by said grandparents, regardless of residence of grandchild without guest fees applying.
6. Children under 5 years of age or non-swimmer, must be supervised by a responsible adult, who is in the water and remains within reach of the child.
7. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Parents are encouraged to monitor their children's activities. Lifeguards are not babysitters. Help our Lifeguards promote safety.
8. Must be of legal age of 21 to consume alcohol at the pool facility.
9. Running an un-scheduled party during pool hours is prohibited. Parties MUST be scheduled through the Pool Manager and/or Golf Shop in order to make sure all safety protocols are followed, namely having the appropriate number of Lifeguards on duty. This also allows all members to enjoy the pool with normal attendance.
10. A "party" is defined as any intended gathering where invitations (whether by text, phone, or written/verbal) are used to celebrate an occasion.
11. Glass Bottles of any kind are not permitted in the pool facility at any time. Cans, plastic, and paper items are acceptable.
12. No Chairs, sunbathing, or congregating around the lifeguard stand. No casual talking to lifeguards while they are on duty.
13. The pool facility is a NON-SMOKING area. No smoking or tobacco products are permitted.
14. No one is allowed on the pool grounds without proper swimming attire. Cut-off jeans are not acceptable.
15. Children wearing diapers shall not be permitted in the pool. SWIM APPROVED diapers are acceptable.
16. Fighting, shoving, standing on shoulders, excessive dunking, splashing, inappropriate intimate contact, or any other horseplay is NOT permitted.
17. No persons having skin lesions, sores, inflamed eyes, or discharge from mouth, ears or nose, or communicable diseases shall use the pool and/or showers.
18. Pets are not allowed in the pool facility.
19. Oakwoods Country Club assumes no liability for lost personal belongings. Items left in the pool area at the end of the day will be placed in the Pool's Lost and Found.
20. Absolutely NO SWIMMING after hours.
21. Do not approach the lifeguards if you disagree with rules or a lifeguard's decision. These issues need to be addressed with the pool Manager or club management.
22. No student or social memberships are allowed to use the pool.

## **GENERAL RULES FOR CHILDREN & PLAYING**

1. No running on the pool deck.
2. No hanging on the rope inside the pool.
3. No hanging or climbing on the pool fences.
4. No hanging on the diving board.
5. Only one diver is permitted on the diving board at a time. You MUST wait until the preceding diver reaches the ladder.
6. No playing or congregating in the bathrooms or locker rooms.
7. Spitting, spouting water, or blowing one's nose in the water is STRICTLY forbidden.
8. No chewing gum is allowed in the pool facility.
9. No diving is allowed from the Lifeguard stand or in the shallow end.
10. Absolutely NO SWIMMING after hours.
11. No balls of any kind in the pool area or Fairways/greens.
12. No playing around the Fairways, on the Fairways or greens.

## **LIFE GUARD RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITY**

1. Only authorized personnel should handle pool equipment or water hoses.
2. Swimmers shall not be permitted in the water over their heads unless they are able to swim (2 widths) in the deep end. Lifeguards have the right to give this test.
3. Lifeguards have the right to stop any unsafe activity.
4. Lifeguards have the right to sit ANY member or guest out for misconduct. Repeat offenses could result in suspension for the day or week.
5. Breaks will be observed every hour on the hour and will last for 10 minutes. Only 18 years or older are allowed in the pool during this time.
6. All Oakwoods Country Club employees have the authority to close the pool at any time for health or weather related issues.
7. The manager/lifeguard on duty has the authority to enforce these rules and may remove any member, or guest, in violation.
8. Failure to adhere to the rules and regulations of Oakwoods Country Club may result in suspension or termination of membership.

## **POOL PARTY RULES**

1. Members age 21 or older may reserve the pool facility for Private Parties by scheduling through the Pool Manager or the Golf Shop.
2. Pool facilities can be reserved outside regular pool hours. The following fees apply:
  - a. Members: Rental is \$150.00 for 1 Lifeguard, \$230.00 for 2 Lifeguards, and \$320.00 for 3 Lifeguards. The number of Lifeguards needed is determined by the number of attendants and the Pool Manager.
  - b. Non-Members: Rental is \$250.00 for 1 Lifeguard, \$330.00 for 2 Lifeguards, and \$420.00 for 3 Lifeguards. The number of Lifeguards needed is determined by the number of attendants and the Pool Manager.
3. The name and phone number of the responsible party must be provided when scheduling a Pool Rental.
4. 15% Gratuity is recommended for each party.
